The Listening Biennial draws attention to listening as a relational capacity, a philosophical and political proposition, a creative practice, and research framework. Conceived as a global project and aiming at a curatorial collective construct grounded on sharing, reciprocity and exchange, the second edition of the Biennial includes the exhibition of circa 30 audio works – works – which are fully sound-based, without visual or physical presence – experimental performances, and discursive events presented across a constellation of collaborating institutions and venues, where listening and locality are accentuated, and cultural specificities contribute to a greater ecology of attention.

Over our conversations with the artists, works with two or more versions emerged, providing different situations, and listening experiences. At the Galeria Quadrum, we are greeted with a soundscape in which we can listen to all the works of the Biennial, in a loop, one after the other, with a maximum duration of 15 minutes each, always introduced by the corresponding authors. From distant pasts, through present conflicts, towards future world(ing)s, the group of works presents itself as a non-linear path of times and geopolitics coinhabited by humans and non-humans. At the Antecâmara, we are invited to listen to the expanded versions of the research works of Ayò Akínwándé, Landra (Sara Rodrigues with Rodrigo Camacho), and Tara Fatehi with Pouya Ehsaei.

In Brotéria's library, a serpentine hallucination taking place across three parallel timelines. *Perturbation: A Speculative History of Future(s) Past* is an audiobook that connects the intertwined geopolitics of the Strait of Hormuz to vastly distant geographies. Performative listening experiences take place at the Stolen Books, in Cais do Sodré (next to Clube Naval de Lisboa), and at the HANGAR. From critical storytelling, experimental noise, and musical rapture to acoustic care, interspecies contact, and environments of sounded matter, the Biennial presents itself as a listening microcosmos co-inhabited both by differences and commonalities.
